SCHOOL SELF REVIEW POLICY STRATEGIC PLANNING

The National Administration Guidelines 2007 require Boards to follow sound governance and management practices involving curriculum, employment, financial and property matters applying to schools.

NAG 2 and 2A

1. To develop strategic plan which document how they are giving effect to the National Education Guideline through their policy, planning and programmes, including those for curriculum, National Standards, assessment and staff professional development.
2. Maintain an ongoing programme of self review.
3. Report to students and their parents on the achievement of individual students and to the schools community on achievement of students as a whole and of groups including achievement of Maori students.

GUIDELINES

Ashburton Borough School's mission is defined and guided through its charter.

The school is organised according to clear Terms of Reference and Job Descriptions. Policies, procedures and supporting documents provide a framework of responsibilities for trustees and staff.

1. The Board will review its Charter together with policies, procedures and supporting documents. Review of Policies and Procedures in the 6 NAGS will be completed triennially. A Policy Sub-Committee will carry out this review. Any change to policy must have the approval of the Board of Trustees.
2. The School Development Plan gives an overview of objectives in each area of governance and enables it to develop, implement and monitor strategies.
3. The Board will maintain a longer term review plan.
4. Adequate budgeting and resourcing is essential to effective school review.

CONCLUSION

Successful School Self Review is based upon sound policy, efficient procedures, clear long term planning, simple formats, realistic timelines and adequate budgeting.
